Introduction

The British Ju-Jitsu Association Governing Body (BJJA GB) is the governing body of ju-jitsu. We are responsible for promoting and developing ju-jitsu at all levels. The BJJA GB oversees all aspects of ju-jitsu in Great Britain such as establishing codes of conduct, standard practises, competition formats and rules, arranging group insurance policies for associations and clubs within the BJJA GB and certification of instructors and competition referees as well as registration of new associations/clubs.

The Role

Each BJJA GB member association or club should have a named EDI Officer.

This person will be the person responsible, within their ju-jitsu setting and their association/club, for promoting equality and supporting instructors, coaches, officials, parents and guardians, volunteers and students to uphold the BJJA GB principle that we will seek to include everyone in the sport of ju-jitsu.

The EDI Officer will ensure that all complaints relating to equality, diversity and inclusion are investigated.



Responsibilities

- Maintain an up-to-date knowledge of relevant EDI legislation and initiatives.
- Provide advice, guidance and support on equality and diversity issues.
- Promote a diverse and inclusive environment within their association or club.
- Raise awareness, challenge status quo and promote great EDI practice.
- Foster a culture where all members feel safe and free from discrimination, bullying, harassment and victimisation.
- Support the BJJ GB EDI Officer with disseminating information and initiatives within their association or club.
- Complete relevant training every 3 years (either the Educare [Equality and Diversity](#) course every 3 years or an equivalent approved by the BJJ GB).
