### Introduction

The British Ju-Jitsu Association Governing Body (BJJA GB) is committed to safeguarding children and adults at risk and making the sport of ju-jitsu accessible to all.

### BJJA GB and Member Association and Club Commitment

The BJJA GB and member associations and clubs will:

- ensure BJJA GB approved safeguarding education and training is available to all instructors/coaches/welfare officers/officials and volunteers; training will be relevant to their role and contact with children and adults at risk;
- ensure BJJA GB approved coaching education and training is available to all instructors and coaches;
- ensure BJJA GB approved equality, diversity and inclusion education and training is available to all instructors/coaches/welfare officers/officials and volunteers;



- ensure that when appointing instructors/coaches/welfare officers/officials and volunteers, their current or previous experience will be considered and references will be used where appropriate;
- ensure that all coaches/instructors/welfare offices/officials and volunteers will have the relevant Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check, relevant to their contact with children and adults at risk;
- ensure that all member associations and clubs will have access to safeguarding and equality policies and codes of conduct;
- ensure that training and education provided on safeguarding and equality for all instructors/coaches/welfare officers/officials and volunteers will be a minimum of 3 hours, every 3 years.

This document is fully supported by the BJJ GB Executive Committee who are responsible for its implementation across the BJJ GB and all of its member associations and clubs.
