

AMENDMENTS TO BJJAGB COMPETITION RULES

As of 3rd October 2010.

Random Attacks

Junior Random Attacks will now be able to demonstrate all defences inclusive of knife and baton defences, as per the senior sections.

Defenders will be marked down if they repeatedly demonstrate the same defence technique.

At the semi-finals and finals stage of the competition the defenders will be scored after each attack.

Cont.Fighting.

Senior rules will now be applicable for the 16 + 17 year old age group.

Tap outs or submissions are to be awarded 3points, not 5.

When a contestant is being strangled or choked the Referee must do a verbal check in addition to the visual check.

The times for cont.fighting are now 1minute for the sparring section. Followed by a maximum time of 45seconds for the Grip/Attempting to Throw Section. Followed by a further 1minute for the groundfighting section.

Fully clenched fists only must be adopted during the sparring section.

Empty Hand Kata and Weapons Kata

There will no longer be a Veterans Section in these categories.

Pairs Demo.

These are to have no theatrical value to their content.

Ref's Footwear.

Formal Black Shoes are to be worn with the Referee's uniform. Casual footwear or boots are unacceptable.
